





FIXTURE ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Read and review installation instruction sheet before assembling the fixture.

- Carefully place the Glass (G) on the outer Cage frame (F), affix using Deco nut (E). Place rubber washer between glass and deco nuts to avoid breaking glass and tighten.
- Place the fixture Cage frame with the glass attached (G+F) onto the Back Plate (D-not shown) against the wall by threading Deco screws (E) until tight as shown on Fig.1

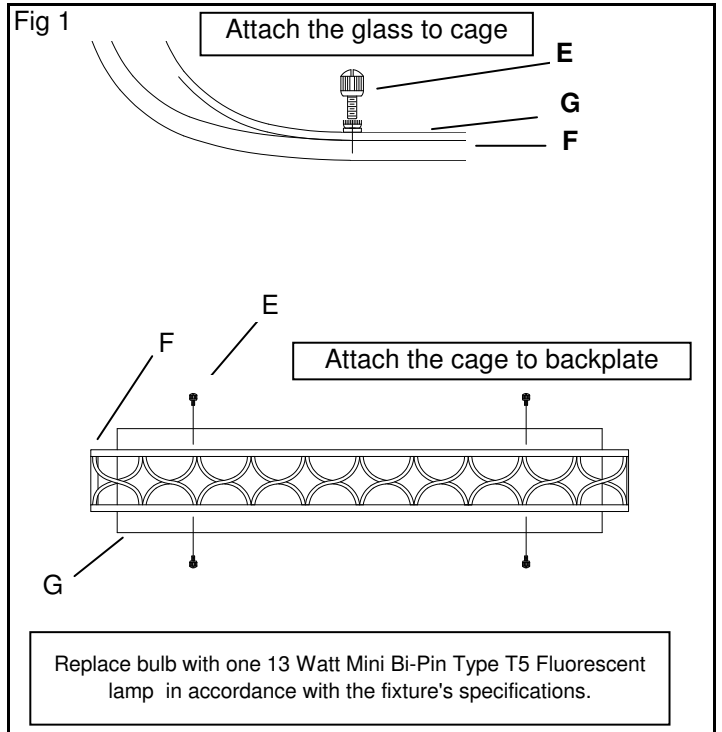
2 YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY

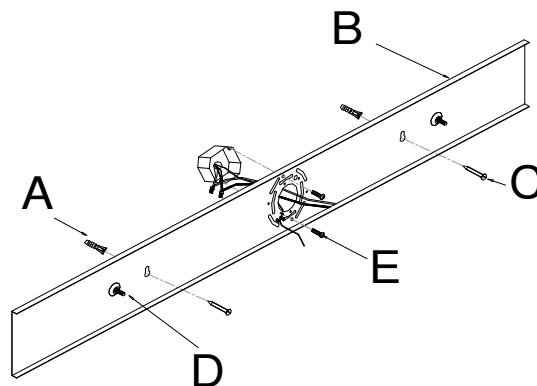

HANGING THE FIXTURE (Fig.1)

1. Carefully remove the new fixture from the carton and the yellow bag that holds all your parts. Check that all parts are included as shown in the illustration and parts list.
2. Shut off power at the circuit breaker and remove the old fixture from wall, including the old mounting strap.
3. Hold Mounting Plate (B) up against the wall aligning the two holes in the Junction Box with appropriate slots in the Mounting Plate (B). Then while the Mounting Plate (B) is leveled horizontally, use a pen or pencil to make a mark on the wall at holes located near each end of mounting Plate (B). Set aside the Mounting Plate (B), pre-drill holes at the marks and insert Wall Anchors (A) into the two marks made on the wall.
4. Secure the Mounting plate (B) to wall by Screwing the wood screws (C) through holes of Mounting plate into plastic anchors (A) of the wall.
5. Thread the supply wires and ground wire from Junction Box through center holes in Mounting Plate(B).

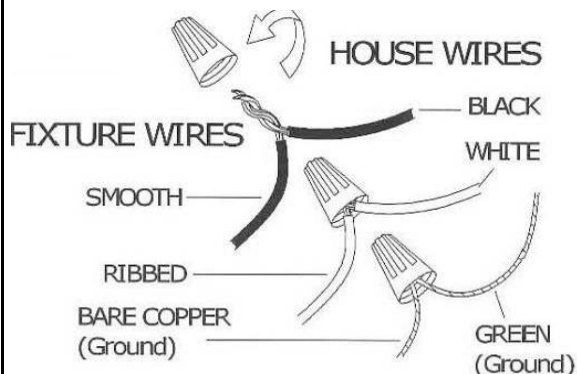

CONNECTING THE WIRES (Fig 2)

6. Attach the power supply wires to the fixture lead wires by connecting BLACK to BLACK (or SMOOTH) and WHITE to WHITE (or RIBBED).
 7. Attach the GROUND wire (GREEN or COPPER) from the Junction Box and the fixture Ground wire to the green Ground Screw on the Mounting Bracket (B) or connect both wires together using the correct size of wire connectors.
- NOTE: Twist the wires together in the same direction you twist the wire connector onto the wires.
8. Tuck these wire connections neatly into the Junction Box.

FINISHING THE INSTALLATION (Fig 3)

9. Place the fixture Back plate (D) onto the Mounting plate (B) against the wall and secure with Deco Screws (E) until tight as shown on Fig.3. The outer Cage frame will be attached after the glass is installed.

YOUR INSTALLATION IS NOW COMPLETE. RETURN POWER TO THE JUNCTION BOX AND TEST THE FIXTURE.
