




Drawing 1 - Fixture Mounting




Vstart here

- 1. Find a clear area in which you can work.
 - 2. Unpack fixture and glass from carton.
 - 3. Carefully review instructions prior to assembly.

*** The construction of this fixture will be accomplished by first installing the glass, assembling the fixture, making all necessary electrical connections, and then mounting the fixture to the pole.

Drawing 2 - Glass Installation



- 1. To install glass, slip bottom edge of glass panel (2) into channel at bottom of cage assembly (1) - see Drawing 1.
 - 2. Secure top of glass panel (2) with bending glass clips (B) over top of glass.
 - 3. Repeat 1-3 for all remaining glass panels (2).
 - 4. Fixture can now be lamped accordingly.
 - 5. Slip cage assembly (1) into roof assembly. line up mounting holes in edge of cage with holes in roof (3) - see Drawing 1.
 - 6. Slip flat head screw (4) through hole in cage and thread into roof to secure cage.

Make electrical connections from supply wire to fixture lead wires. Refer to instruction sheet (I.S. 18) and follow all instructions to make all necessary wiring connections. Then refer back to this sheet to continue installation of this fixture.

- 1. After wiring connections are complete, slip post fitter (A) over top of pre-installed post (B) making sure all wire connections are tucked inside the pole - see Drawing 1.
- 2. When fixture is slipped over pole make sure no wires are being pinched between the top edge of the pole and the inside of the post fitter.
- 3. Thread the 3 set screws (C) into pre-tapped holes in post fitter.
- 4. Tighten screw (C) to secure fixture to post.

Note: Maximum wattage for 1461 fixture is 100 watts per bulb.
