
ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS FOR YOUR

ALBERT FLOOR LAMP



IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS:

- * This lamp has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other) as a feature to reduce the risk of electric shock. This plug will fit in a polarized outlet only one way. If it does not fit fully in the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. Do NOT alter the plug.
- * Do not use with an extension cord unless the plug from the lamp can be fully inserted into the extension cord receptical.
- * Switch power off and remove plug from the wall outlet before replacing the bulb.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS:

NOTE: Do not connect electricity until lamp is fully assembled.

- 1. Unpack all parts and place them on a level work surface. Remove and discard all packing materials.
- 2. Use wrench (E) to remove screws (D) from housing (C).
- 3. Place column (A) into the opening in housing (C). Thread screws (D) into housing (C) to secure position of column (A). Use wrench (E) to tighten screws (D).
- 4. Insert one 100W Max. Type A, medium base bulb into the socket, located inside shade (B).
- 5. Carefully move column (A) in desired position. Carefully move shade (B) into desired position.
- 6. Insert polarized plug (F) into wall outlet.

^{**} To clean, wipe lamp with a soft cloth. Do not use any chemical or abrasive cleaners as they may damage the finish. **
