

## **ASSEMBLY & INSTALLATION GUIDE**



WE RECOMMEND INSTALLATION OF THIS LIGHTING FIXTURE BE DONE BY A LICENSED ELECTRICIAN.

WARNING \*\*\* SWITCH OFF THE MAIN ELECTRICAL SUPPLY FROM THE MAIN FUSE BOX/CIRCUIT BREAKER BEFORE INSTALLATION.

INSPECT ITEM CAREFULLY BEFORE ATTEMPTING TO INSTALL. IF THERE IS ANY DAMAGE OR OBVIOUS DEFECT, DO NOT INSTALL.

## ITEM MAY NOT BE RETURNED ONCE IT HAS BEEN INSTALLED.

- 1. Screw pole (I) onto top nipple of fixture body (K).
- 2. Attach chain (F) to top loop (G) by using side cut link provided.
- 3. Attach the other side cut link to the loop (E) at bottom of canopy base (C).
- 4. Feed wire through chain (F) and canopy base (C).
- 5. Connect the safety steel wire from the fixture to the safety cable from ceiling with lock nut as show in illustration A.
- Attach ground (silver or copper in color) wire to ground wire from wall outlet box (usually green or copper in color),
  fasten together with a plastic wire connector. Tightly wrap the wire connector with electrical tape so the end of the
  connector is sealed.
  - IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT THE OUTLET BOX IN YOUR HOME BE PROPERLY GROUNDED.
- 7. Connect neutral (Ribbed) fixture wire coming from fixture base to neutral (usually white) outlet wire. Fasten both wires together with a plastic wire connector and tightly wrap the wire connector with electrical tape.
- 8. Repeat the procedure with the hot (Round) wire. Always make sure that no wire strands are left outside the connectors.
  - DO NOT REVERSE THE HOT AND NEUTRAL CONNECTIONS OR SAFETY WILL BE COMPROMISED.
- 9. Remove back plate (A) from canopy base (C) by unscrewing base screws (D).
- 10. Attach back plate (A) to ceiling outlet box and secure with mounting screws (B).
- 11. Attach canopy base (C) to affixed back plate (A) and secure with base screws (D).
- 12. Attach side opening of shade spider to threaded rod and secure with ring (H).
- 13. Insert light bulbs into sockets.
